## Class Officer Applications Packet

Thank you for taking interest in being a class officer! First off, in order to run you must have at least a 2.8 GPA with no F's. These elections should be taken seriously and if elected all of the listed duties must be fulfilled. The position and duties for each class officer are listed below

#### President:

- 1. Preside at all the meetings of the class council and to assume the duties generally assigned to the office of the president. This includes all poster paintings, food sales, class rally games, forming committees and bingo.
- 2. Be exempt from holding more than office if chosen for the chairperson of the inter-organizational council.
- 3. Be a member of the IOC.
- 4. Be enrolled in 4<sup>th</sup> period leadership class.
- 5. Be in constant communication with the class advisors.
- Senior class president will present the president's closing speech at graduation.
- Junior class president will assist class advisors in planning junior/senior prom.

#### Vice President:

- Assume the office of president in the absence of the president, thereby being responsible for fulfilling the duties of the president.
- 2. Take over in the absence of the president or social chairperson at the IOC scheduled meetings.
- 3. Be responsible for maintaining an up to date file of class council minute in the activities office.
- 4. Be in constant communication with the president and class advisors
- 5. Participate in officer meetings and committee meetings.

### Secretary/ Treasurer:

- 1. Keep a record of all meeting and attend the correspondence of the class as a whole
- Keep accurate attendance records regular and standing member of the class council.

- 3. Handle class funds in accordance with USB policies and regulations.
- 4. Be in constant communication with the club advisors.

#### Social Chairperson:

- 1. Represent class as a voting member of the inter-organizational.
- 2. Report to class council the business and activities of the IOC.
- 3. Be responsible for turning activity request for any class activity to the executive board, namely the commissioner of social activities
- 4. Be chairperson for all committees for class activities.
- Keep an accurate record of all class activities in scrapbook, which will be passed on from year to year and stored in the activities office. Records will be available at all class reunions.

#### Historian:

- Keep an accurate record of all class activities in scrapbook, which will be passed on from year to year and stored in the activities office. Records will be available at all class reunions.

If you do not attend this meeting, come late, or turn in your application late, you will automatically be disqualified. No exceptions. Please come on time and prepared with any questions you may have.

### Week of May 17th-20th

- Election Week! You will be allowed to hang posters and start campaigning on Monday, May 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 am. Any fliers or posters put up before 7am will be taken down and cause for immediate disqualification. Posters not hung correctly will be removed (see poster regulation paper). Reminder: if you have a zero period you will NOT be excused to hang posters. You may start your campaign according to the guidelines discussed.

## Wednesday May 19th

- All candidate speeches at lunch. Meet 15 minutes before the end of fourth period in the lower lunch area. You will be given one minute to present yourself to the student body at lunch. Please make your speeches appropriate and you are not allowed to slander your opponents. If your speech is inappropriate you will be disqualified.

### Thursday May 20th

-Voting will take place during fourth period.
