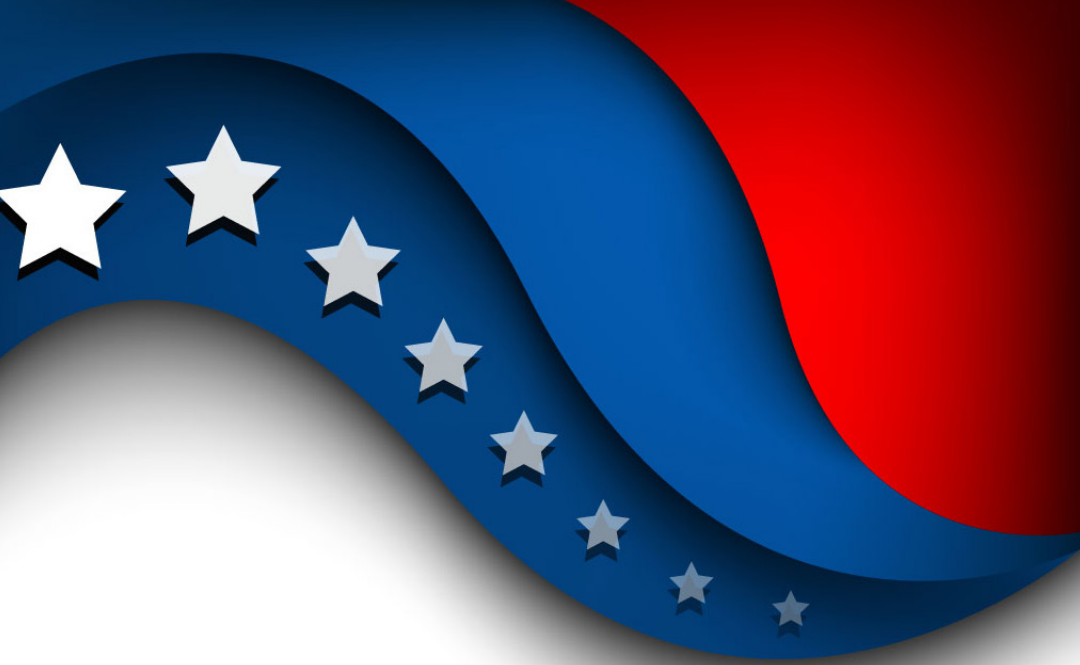

Founder Profile

AUECEF was founded by Mr. Dinghua Wang who is also known as Dannies Wang, an entrepreneur and philanthropist who believes that educational and program opportunities will help foster greater Asian Pacific Americans' awareness and participation in the democratic process.



In 1997, Mr. Wang emigrated from China to Los Angeles California to achieve the Golden California dream for his family. Prior to the start up of E-World U.S.A Holding, Inc. Mr. Wang began his business career with a humble beginning starting as a bonsai sale associate earning merely \$4.50 an hour. Through hard work and determination he went on to own his first small business selling Chinese medicine and nutritional supplements in 1999. In 2005, he ventured his business to wholesale of OEM nutritional products. With much success, in 2007, E-World USA Holding, Inc. was officially launched.

Mr. Wang believes in providing support to those who are less fortunate and contributed to various charitable causes. More recently, Mr. Wang donated \$50,000, the biggest sum the Chinese consulate has received, to Yunnan disaster providing relief to victims impacted by the catastrophic earthquake.



Aside from philanthropic activities, Mr. Wang is involved in various capacities assisting economic and agricultural development between China and California. He is a member of the Cabinet Committee on National Affairs and Economic for Speaker Emeritus Nancy Pelosi. As minister of the California Department of Agricultural Development, Mr. Wang helps strengthen collaborative exchange between China and California on the development of agricultural system, technology, and environmental protection. Additionally, he serves as Chief of World Chinese Entrepreneur Investment Foundation, Director of Hobart Independent Research Lab, and Vice President of MIIT Information and Technology Co., Ltd.

He studied at the Zhejiang Chinese Medical University in 1986. He also studied at the Samra University of Oriental Medicine in 2000 and alternative medicine in 2003.

Elite Youth Empowerment Program

It is AUECEF's goal to instill high school students with knowledge and skills to become effective leaders in the community and encourage their consideration of careers in the public service sector.

Twenty-five junior and senior students from Los Angeles and Orange counties schools will be chosen to participate in a four-week youth empowerment program. Students are encouraged to apply. The summer program consists of weekly seminars, which allow youth to gain leadership skills and understand the democratic process through lectures by community leaders, elected officials, and veteran politicians.

After the lectures, students will have an opportunity to practice key concepts by participating in a mock activity from the following categories: advocacy campaign, election, and legislative hearing.

Five students from the Elite Student Empowerment Program will be selected to participate in a two-week internship program with placement in a congressional, state legislative, or local elected official's office.

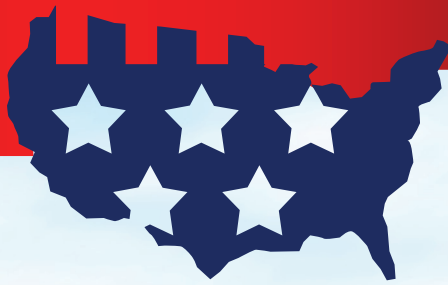
