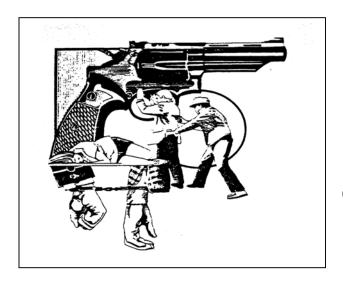
CRIME QUIZ #7
