COURSE REQUIREMENTS/CLASS EXPECTATIONS

ATTENDANCE:

- 1. Be in class and on time. (School cut/tardy policy will be enforced) **POOR ATTENDANCE WILL AFFECT YOUR GRADE**
- 2. Tardies or absences will result in **NO CREDIT ZERO** for the class opening activity unless you make up the activity by printing it at home from my webpage and turning it in the **NEXT** day you are in class for 80% credit.
- 3. Class work missed due to absence which cannot be assigned as make-up will result in (<u>M/A</u>) exempt THIS DOES NOT HURT OR HELP YOUR GRADE. (IE: Video Points). If you are in class the activity will help your grade unless you lose points for not paying attention. (SLEEPING OR DOING OTHER NON CLASS RELATED WORK). Repeated infractions may result in a referral to GLC.

CHEATING:

<u>GRADING POLICY:</u>

- 1. Based on **accumulated point total** for the following assignments:
- a. quizzes and tests b. classwork c. homework d. extra credit e. attendance g. class participation 2. *Grades will be based on the following*:
 - a. "A" Excellent 90-100%
 - b. <u>"B" Superior</u> 80-89% (MINIMUM GRADE FOR COLLEGE CREDIT)
 - c. "C" Average" 70-79%
 - d. "D" Below ave. 69-55%
 - e. "F" Failing 54% and below
- 3. If you have questions about your grade or missed work please see me before, after class or send me an email.

<u>HOMEWORK</u>:

 Homework is due on the assigned day to be collected and graded. LATE WORK will be accepted one day late if you were in class on the day it was assigned for 50% credit. If you are absent the day it is due then, it becomes due the next day you return to class. Accept RESPONSIBILITY for your required work and turn it in on time.

QUIZZES AND OPENING ACTIVITIES:

- Terminology quizzes will be given. If you are absent on the day of a quiz you must make it up on the designated make-up day or you will receive a zero. There will be no make ups for missing a class video that has a grade component. You will receive a N/A.
- 2. If you are absent for an opening activity go to my webpage and print the assignment. Complete the activity and turn it in the day you return to class for partial credit. (4 out of 5 points for example).

TESTS AND EXAMS:

- You have designated make up days and times after your return to class to make up a test. A make up test will be taken on **DESIGNATED MAKE UP DAYS IN CLASS** (make arrangements with the instructor). Generally the days make-ups are given are when we have a video scheduled so <u>CHECK MY</u> <u>CALENDAR ONLINE</u>.
- 2. **UNEXCUSED ABSENCES** on the day of any test, or assignment due may result in a failure or point penalty for that assignment.
- 3. **UNEXCUSED TARDY** on the day of any test, or assignment due may result in a failure or point penalty for that assignment.
