# **Tryout Checklist**

In order to participate in the Diamond Bar Dance Company tryouts, each candidate must return the following documents **no later Monday**, **April 8 at 3:00pm**.

- DBHS Dance Company completed application with current picture.
- 2 Teacher evaluation forms
  - New DBHS Students from either teacher(s) and/or counselor
  - o Current DHBS Students one must be from GLC.
  - o Returning Company members one from GLC; one from Coach
- A copy of your Fall 2018 Grades & 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester 6-week (current DBHS students) or Grade Check (8<sup>th</sup> Grade students)
- \$10 Audition contribution (towards costs of clinic and judges)
- DBHS Permission to Participate Form
- DBHS Dance Company Rules and Policies (page 10 only of Handbook) signed by both parent(s) and student.

# **What to Wear for Tryouts:**

- All Black; must be in dancewear. No overly baggy clothes.
- Appropriate shoes for style
- Slicked pony tail or bun
- No bare midriffs, gum, or jewelry
- NO PAST OR CURRENT DBHS DANCE COMPANY UNIFORMS ALLOWED

## **Dance Company Selection**

Candidates are responsible for all material taught at tryouts. Candidates will perform in front of Dance Director, Coaches and/or outside judges.

Dance Company will be determined by clinic attendance, attitude and behavior, grades, teacher recommendations, skill level, performance quality, etc.. Criteria may include, but not limited to: Use of technique, Dance combination(s), Improv, Appearance, Knowledge of material, and showmanship.

Dance Director reserves the right to eliminate or combine teams based on the number of qualified candidates. Final selection of teams is at the discretion of the Dance Director.

Completed packets can be turned in to Mrs. Simonson in the Dance Room or DBHS Front Office no later than Monday, April 8. Late applications will NOT be accepted.
